petra in modern southern jordan is universally known as one of the most frequented touristic sites in the near east inscribed on the unesco world heritage list modern visitors are attracted by the romantic aspect of the rock cut tomb façades heavily contrasting in their baroque stile with the desert like surrounding of the rocky and arid landscape these monuments were the result of the long time presence of the arab tribe of the nabataeans who made petra their capital when they became at least partially sedentarised during the hellenistic period i e between the late 4th to late 1st centuries bce how exactly this process of sedentarisation happened how the site of petra changed from a temporary dwelling place of a small bedouin tribe to one of the blinking capitals of the ancient near east that attracted as it is the case today visitors from all over the world was

the subject of a three years research program jointly sponsored by the french agence nationale de la recherche anr and the german research foundation dfg at the end of the program an international conference held in berlin in december 2011 brought together several dozen of scholars from all over the world in order to pinpoint the state of research on the formation of the nabataean capital the contributions of the present volume focus on questions related to the natural environment of the site on the geology and geography as well as on architecture small finds and social dynamics probably the clue for a better understanding of the functioning of the nabataean kingdom and its capital petra

architecture and freehand drawing are inextricably linked even in the gothic period the principle applied what you can t build you at least draw the same applies to the sketches of wolf dprix co founder and ceo of coop himmelb l au over the 53 years of their creation prix s sketches formed the first stage of every design despite rapid developments in digital architecture whereas his freehand drawings were proxies for completed projects in the 1960s and 1970s today they serve as strategic guides to the firm s complex buildings from 2 800 archival drawings 1 300 examples were selected for publication to represent developmental dynamics in an archive like format as invaluable documents of architectural history they illustrate some 320 selected projects

## **Trypillia Mega-Sites and European Prehistory 2016**

in european prehistory population agglomerations of more than 10 000 inhabitants per site are a seldom phenomenon a big surprise to the archaeological community was the discovery of trypillia mega sites of more than 250 hectares and with remains of more than 2000 houses by a multidisciplinary approach of soviet and ukrainian archaeology including aerial photography geophysical prospection and excavations nearly 50 years ago the extraordinary development took place at the border of the north pontic forest steppe and steppe zone ca 4100 3400 bce since then many questions arose which are of main relevance why how and under which environmental conditions did trypillia mega sites develop how long did they last were social and or ecological reasons responsible for this social experiment are trypillia and the similar sized settlement of uruk two different concepts of social behaviour paradigm change in fieldwork and excavation strategies enabled research teams during the last decade to analyse the mega sites in their spatial and social complexity high precision geophysics target excavations and a new design of systematic field strategies deliver empirical data representative for the large sites archaeological research contributed immensely to aspects of anthropogenic induced steppe development and subsistence concepts that did not reach the carrying capacities probabilistic models based on 14c dates made the contemporaneity of the mega site house structures most probable in



consequence trypillia mega sites are an independent european phenomenon that contrasts both concepts of urbanism and social stratification that is seen with similar demographic figures in mesopotamia the new trypillia research can be read as the methodological progress in european archaeology

## ***The Farm as a Social Arena 2014-04-01***

the farm as a social arena focusses on the social life of farms from prehistory until c 1700 ad based mainly but not exclusively on archaeological sources all over europe people have lived on farms at least from the bronze age onwards the papers presented here discuss farms in norway sweden iceland and germany whether isolated or in hamlets or villages farms have been important elements of the social structure for thousands of years farms were workplace and home for their inhabitants women men and children and perhaps extended families frequently sharing their space with domestic animals sometimes important events such as feasts religious services and funerals also took place here the household thus became a multi faceted arena which brought together a variety of community members that both shaped and were shaped by its social dynamics at times work and other activities defined by the social arena that was the farm even affected long term developments of society as such with contributions by birgitta berglund timo bremer timothy carlisle liv helga dommasnes doris gutsmiedl schümann alf tore hommedal karen milek emma nordström kristin armstrong oma helge sørheim and inger storli

in the past decade a range of formal spatial analysis methods has been developed for the study of human engagement experience and socialisation within the built environment many although not all of these emanate from the fields of architectural and urban studies and draw upon social theories of space that lay emphasis on the role of visibility movement and accessibility in the built environment these approaches are now gaining in popularity among researchers of prehistoric and historic built spaces and are given increasingly more weight in the interpretation of past urban environments spatial analysis and social spaces brings together contributions from specialists in archaeology social theory and urban planning who explore the theoretical and methodological frameworks associated with the application of new and established spatial analysis methods in past built environments the focus is mainly on more recent computer based approaches and on techniques such as access analysis visibility graph analysis isovist analysis agent based models of pedestrian movement and 3d visibility approaches the contributors to this volume
