Flying Solo 1981-09-01 when newcastle united crashed out of the fa cup in cardiff in april 2005 it was official the second best supported club in england and the eleventh richest in the world had completed 50 years without winning a domestic trophy since their last success an fa cup win in 1955 no less than thirty two clubs have won one of the three major prizes in the english game but not the magpies in that half century they ve employed some of the biggest names in world football yet most of their fanatical supporters have never seen them win a pot in 2004 sir bobby robson paid the price for failing to bring the holy grail to the geordie faithful and in 2006 graeme souness was next to go the 17th manager to try and fail to win one of english football s glittering prizes for the longest suffering fans in the land in newcastle united fifty years of hurt ged clarke examines this extraordinary football phenomenon with all the humour you would expect from a disappointed but dedicated united fan he chronicles the decades of disaster and talks to newcastle legends such as peter beardsley les ferdinand jack charlton bob moncur and malcolm macdonald in a bid to discover an explanation for the longest losing streak in top class football

Newcastle United 2011-11-04 pioneer aviatrix jessie chubbie miller made a significant contribution to aviation history the first woman to fly from england to her native australia as co pilot with her close friend captain bill lancaster she was also the first woman to fly more than 8000 miles to cross the equator in the air and to traverse the australian continent north to south moving to america miller was a popular member of a group of female aviators that included amelia earhart bobby trout pancho barnes and louise thaden as a competitor in international air races and a charter member of the first organization for women flyers the ninety nines she quickly became famous her career was interrupted by her involvement in lancaster s sensational miami trial for the murder of her lover haden clarke and by lancaster s disappearance a few years later while flying across the sahara desert

Flying Solo 2012-05-01 this is the autobiography of an outstanding fighter pilot during his twenty year career with the royal air force tony doyle first flew when in the ccf where he completed a glider course and then a highly prized flying scholarship this opened the way to joining the raf and becoming an all weather tactical fighter pilot flying de havilland vampires and gloster meteors at this he excelled and was posted as a flying instructor and then staff instructor this was the age when the jet provost was the standard training aircraft during 1962 he was selected to fly with the newly formed red pelicans aerobatic display team and honed his skills as a display pilot tony moved to raf valley as the new folland gnat was being introduced in the training role this diminutive aircraft was somewhat of a breakthrough and after ironing out several design problems it proved a superb aircraft being fast and agile the general public were eager to see this new raf addition and tony became its display pilot flying at open days throughout the uk and europe in 1964 tony converted to the english electric lightning britain s one and only supersonic fighter with a top speed in excess of mach 2 and a ceiling of 50 000 feet he was posted to treble one squadron at wattisham in october 1964 as part of the quick reaction alert force against potential russian bomber attacks once again he became the lightning s chosen low level display pilot and demonstrated it at the 1965 paris air show shortly after this he was forced to eject over the north cornish coast after an engine explosion cause the loss of elevator control this fascinating account of front line

and display flying goes into considerable detail of the aerodynamic qualities of the types flown their dangers and advantages there are many life threatening incidents and successes that will educate anyone who is interested in flying at the very edge

Chasing the Morning Sun: Flying Solo 'Round the World in a Homebuilt Aircraft: the Ultimate Adventure 2011 pauline gower was the leader of the spitfire women during the second world war after gaining her pilot s licence at 20 she set up the first female joyriding business in 1931 with engineer dorothy spicer and took 33 000 passengers up for a whirl clocking up more than 2 000 hours overall pauline went on to command the inaugural women s section of the air transport auxiliary ata and achieved equal pay for her women pilots she enabled them to fly anything to anywhere including tiger moths hurricanes wellingtons and their firm favourite the spitfire pauline gower pioneering leader of the spitfire women is a story of bravery fortitude and political persuasion pauline was a clear leader of her time and a true pioneer of flight she died after giving birth at only 36 a life cut tragically short but one of significant achievements pauline left a huge legacy for women in aviation

Flying Solo Again 2016 captain stephen wynn vickers joined the cheshire regiment in august 1914 but after being badly wounded he remustered to the rfc royal flying corps while other young pilots were killed or injured almost as soon as they got their wings captain vickers survived numerous crash and forced landings he joined 101 squadron in 1917 and completed seventy three sorties over enemy territory before being repatriated in may 1918 and awarded the newly inaugurated dfc as well as the mc with the war drawing to a close he became a flying instructor at an raf station in lincolnshire but he did not live long enough to receive either his medals or the distinction that he deserved making use of an array of unpublished material including original images and information collected directly from vickers family former raf air traffic controller joe bamford recounts on of the final original stories of the first world war night bombers

Newcastle United Cult Heroes 2012-11-06 this book takes you raid by raid through the author s tour of operational duty over the last five months of 1944 it is a bomber pilot s story but it is also about the grinding operational pressure the brotherhood of the crew and fears of injury and death it is about a squadron of bomber command that bore a barely equalled burden in operational effort and losses it is about young airmen the author knew who lived and too often died amid the turmoil in enemy skies it is not unusual these days to find authors getting their first book into print in the wrong half of their seventies but far less common to find an individual wartime experiences book justifying a second edition barely two years after its original publication thoughtfully and attractively written this well produced softback is a very good read at an inexpensive price raf historical society an excellent account once again one marvels at the courage of bomber command aircrew in the face of appalling odds air pictorial harry yates book is compelling reading it is well illustrated and a valuable addition to the enthusiast s bookshelf ix squadron association the author is an intelligent and sensitive man and his book reflects these qualities detailed accounts of his experiences are set out including several astonishing incidents there are some good contemporary photographs that add to his recall of desperate days when however individuals might conspire to hide it the continuing emotion for all aircrew members must have been dread he grieves for his many comrades and so will you if you read his book pilot
