Set in Authority 1946 w e b du bois was a public intellectual sociologist and activist on behalf of the african american community he profoundly shaped black political culture in the united states through his founding role in the naacp as well as internationally through the pan african movement du bois s sociological and historical research on african american communities and culture broke ground in many areas including the history of the post civil war reconstruction period du bois was also a prolific author of novels autobiographical accounts innumerable editorials and journalistic pieces and several works of history black reconstruction in america tells and interprets the story of the twenty years of reconstruction from the point of view of newly liberated african americans though lambasted by critics at the time of its publication in 1935 black reconstruction has only grown in historical and literary importance in the 1960s it joined the canon of the most influential revisionist historical works its greatest achievement is weaving a credible lyrical historical narrative of the hostile and politically fraught years of 1860 1880 with a powerful critical analysis of the harmful effects of democracy including jim crow laws and other injustices with a series introduction by editor henry louis gates jr and an introduction by david leveraging lewis this edition is essential for anyone interested in african american history
